About



The inaugural edition of IntraPac India, a premier Exhibition focusing on the Packaging Industry, commenced at 11:00 AM on March 14, 2024, at the India Expo Centre, Greater Noida. 

The company must submit a duly filled application form with requisite supporting documents. The application form link for:

1. Regular Members:

There are three categories of Membership:

1. Regular Membership: Regular Member will consist of a person, firm or body corporate engaged in the manufacturing of Printing, Packaging, Signage, Digital, Allied Machinery, the Governing Council may Consider to be eliqible.

Documents required:

- a) Proof of Machine Manufacturer like GST Returns indicating printing or packaging machine manufacturer.
- b) Hard copy of Duly filled in, signed and stamped application form
- c) Memorandum and Articles of Association, if applicable.
- d) Last two years Trading and P&L Account copy (Duly attested by CA).
- e) Recommendation letter from one IPAMA Regular Member.
- f) Company's Brochure and Proof of Registered & Factory Address.
- **2. Associate Membership:** Associate Member will consist of persons, firm or body corporate associated with Trading of Printing, Packaging, Signage, Digital, Allied Machinery & Materials and trades like Component manufacturers, Advertising agencies or organization with aims and objectives related with or similar to those of the Association, the Governing Council may consider eligible.

Documents required:

- A) Documents supporting that the Company is engaged in the trade of Printing, Packaging and allied Material.
- B) Proof of Registered and Factory Address.
- C) Duly filled in, signed and stamped application form.
- D) PAN Number/GST Number & Brochure.
- E) Recommendation letter from one IPAMA Regular Member.
- **3. Technocrat Members:** Technocrat Member will consist of individuals who have specialized or achieved distinction in the Graphic Arts or packaging field.

Documents required: Documents supporting that candidate himself is specialized or achieved distinction in the Graphic Arts field.
